EJ is a family-owned business that started in 1883 which is managed by the fifth generation of William E. Malpass. Over the years the company has grown to be a global leader in the design, manufacturing, and distribution of access solutions for the world's growing infrastructure. Products include manhole covers and frames, catch basins and curb inlet grates and frames, trench grates, tree grates, and other products utilized in access to the world's infrastructure. EJ also provides water supply systems including fire hydrants and valves, valve boxes, and various water supply products. EJ has manufacturing operations in multiple countries and currently supplies products to projects in 6 out of the 7 continents.



East Jordan Foundry was a greenfield foundry that started in November of 2018. The new foundry in Elmira was built to replace the original East Jordan foundry located just 14 miles away. It is situated on a 200-acre site with 7 ½ acres under roof. The foundry consists of four induction furnaces, two molding lines, and a 300+ ton/hour sand system.
